The Westside Suns Basketball Club is a family friendly all-inclusive club that offers basketball programs for all ages and genders. The club strives to offer all local children the opportunity to play grass roots basketball. Playing basketball provides an opportunity for children to develop skills, be part of a team and make new friends. We hope the following information will answer many of the questions you may have.

The Westside Basketball Club was established in 2012. We have 74 teams and ~600 players. Our Lil' Suns, Junior Suns and 3x3 Programs form a pathway to provide skills and understanding to allow our youngest players to successfully transition to playing for the Westside Suns.

Our teams compete in the Westgate Association domestic competition which is conducted on Saturdays.

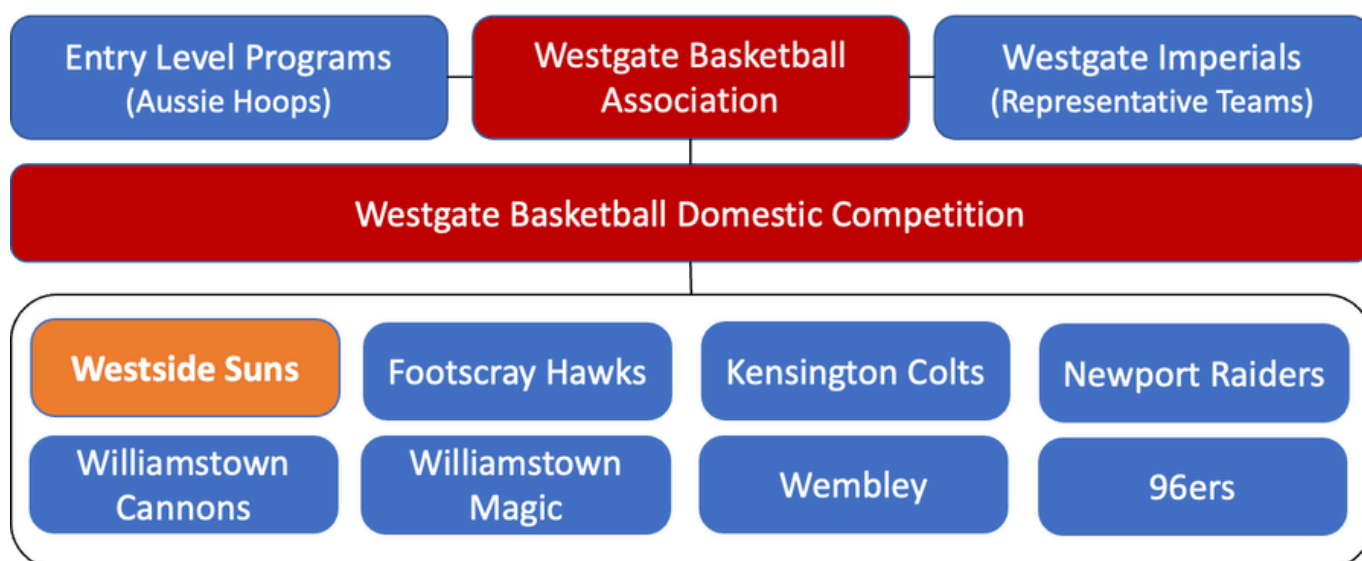

Association Structure

The Westside Suns are a member club of the **Westgate Basketball Association**. The association manages three elements; the Saturday domestic competition that we participate in, the Westgate Imperials (the Association's representative teams that play in the Friday Night Victorian Junior Basketball League competition) and an entry-level program; Aussie Hoops.

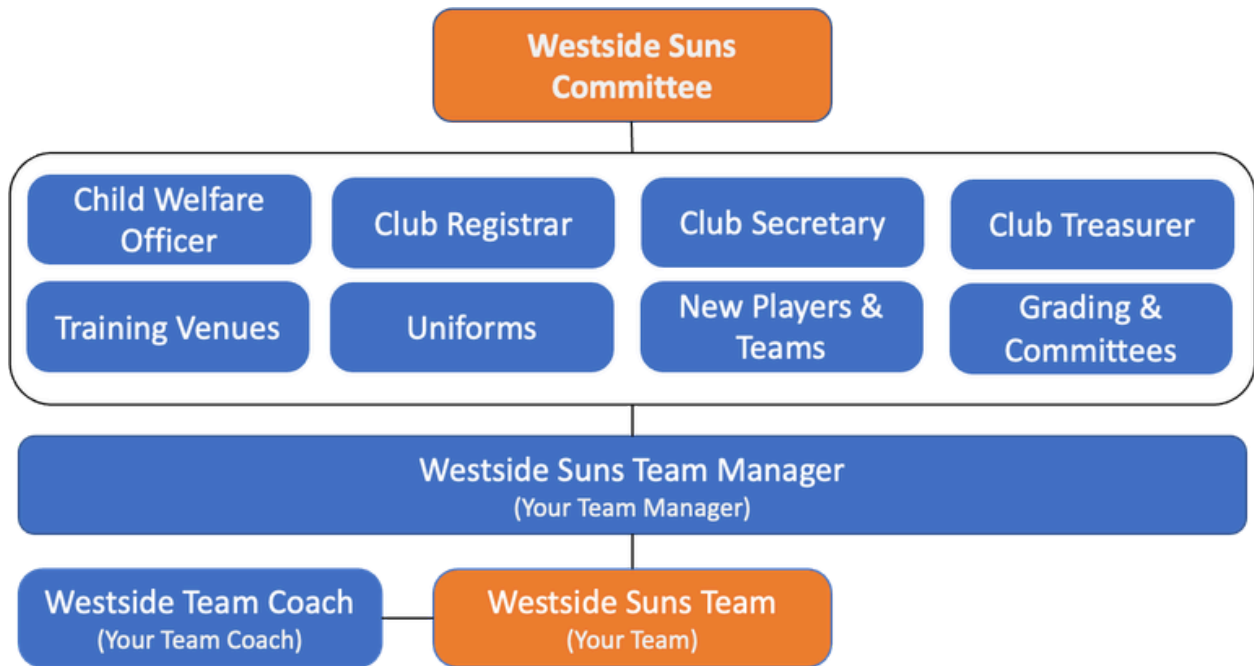

Westside Basketball Club Structure

The Westside Suns club is structured around each team operating as a separate group, with a volunteer coach and team manager. The coach is responsible for coaching the team during practices and on game-day. The Team Managers role is primarily administrative/co-ordination, acting as the link between the team and the club.

In the first instance, if you have any questions or issues, these should be raised with your Team Manager, who can directly contact the relevant person in the club's administration.

Team

Each Team will have one (1) training session and play one (1) game each week (assuming there is no bye in their division). Each team has a similar structure; a volunteer coach, a volunteer team manager and between 8 and 10 children in the team.

Coach

This role may be filled by a parent or a non-parent coach. Most teams are coached by a parent. The role of the coach will be to run your training session and coach the team on game day; all administrative matters are left to the Team Manager. No prior experience is required, so we'd love to see you join our coaching family!

Team Manager

This role is filled by a parent on the team. The Team Manager is the liaison between the club and the team and will be your first port of call for issues or queries. The team manager will inform parents of game details, disseminate information and to arrange scorers for the games.

Players

The club places children in teams based on years of birth wherever possible, so if your child is born in 2015, you will find that most / all other children in the team will also be born in 2015. This is done so that all children in the team have the same age eligibility each season.

Age eligibility is determined by the age of the child on 31 December of the year that the season ends.

Team Uniform

Your team manager will organise a singlet and shorts for your child. These singlets/shorts are supplied free of charge, with the expectation that they will be returned when your child outgrows them or leaves the club.

Training Sessions

Your team will be assigned one (1) 60-minute training session each week. It is important that children attend training each week. Each player will need to bring their own ball.

Size 5 - U10G, U10B, U12G, U12B

Size 6 - U14G, U14B, U16G, U19G

Size 7 - U16B, U18B

Registration Fees

The Westside Suns Basketball Club offers competitively priced fees which are calculated each season. The club offers a family discount for the 2nd and 3rd child. These fees cover team registration, training sessions and game fees. For Winter 26 these fee's were \$330 (U10-U19) & \$230 (U8).

In addition to club fees there is also an annual Basketball Victoria registration charge (currently \$34/annum) and a Basketball Australia registration charge (currently \$5.5/annum). Spectator entrance fee occurs at any VU venue, applicable to anyone aged 10+ (currently set at \$2.20).
